### **SCHOOL BOARD MEETS DECEMBER 9<sup>TH</sup> IN COMMUNITY ROOM**

*Focus of regular monthly meeting includes Student Council President*

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Peru Central's Board of Education is set for the full range of monthly business at its regular meeting, Tuesday, December 9, 2008 at 6 PM at the community room, adjacent to the high school's main entrance. An executive session associated with collective bargaining and the performance history of particular employees will take place immediately following the 6 PM start. The school board is slated to reconvene for public session business **at 7 PM**. It's anticipated the school board will:

- Welcome the student council president, as part of the regular monthly report on extra-curricular student activities, leadership development and service;
- Approve a proposed timetable for recruitment of a successor Primary School Principal, since veteran Principal Chris Angevine is slated to retire July 2009;
- Discuss the final report from the State Commission on Property Tax Relief, and the associated chart of student enrollment among the region's public school districts;
- Complete a preliminary first reading of various updated district policies recommended by the New York State School Boards Association, as part of the school district's comprehensive updating of its policy handbook;
- Discuss the fact-based monthly programs reports and operations reports from each grade span and each operations department, associated with continuous improvement and governing team oversight of programs and services;
- Attend to the full range of monthly school district governance and finance matters.
