SCHOOL BOARD MEETS JANUARY 12TH IN COMMUNITY ROOM

Focus of regular monthly meeting includes EXCEL Capital Project

Peru Central's Board of Education is set for the full range of monthly business at its regular meeting, Tuesday, January 12, 2010 at 6 PM at the community room, adjacent to the high school's main entrance. An executive session associated with the performance history of particular employees, along with collective negotiations matters, will take place immediately following the 6 PM start. The school board is slated to reconvene for public session business **at approximately 7 PM**. It's anticipated the school board will:

- Recognize distinctive student and staff achievement;
- Accept and discuss the fourth annual '**State of the District**' report from the Superintendent of Schools;
- Authorize the school district to consolidate district office management-confidential clerical positions, via attrition, due to a retirement last month;
- Discuss the upcoming public forum for district residents who wish to engage in budget development discussions. That forum is part of the second meeting of the school board's budget advisory committee. The public forum on budget development is slated for 6 PM in the community room, Monday, January 25th.
- Receive a verbal early progress report from the school business administrator regarding feedback so far on the Town of Peru sidewalk proposal for School Street;
- Attend to the full range of monthly school district governance and finance matters.
