

and prioritize their applications. They are listed below in order of priority.

1. Reservoir Sediment Trap, Furnace Brook - \$85,000 - Protect the Town's interest/investment in water quality.
2. Maiden Land Pump Station - \$100,000 - Mitigation of a recurring capacity problem.
3. Maiden Lane Pump Station Emergency Generator - \$48,300 - Provide emergency power and ability to focus on other essential work during emergencies.
4. North Bend Sewer Trunk Line - \$326,000 - Mitigation of a recurring capacity problem.
5. Bear Swamp Road Pump Station Emergency Generator - \$48,300 - Provide emergency power and ability to focus on other essential work during emergencies.
6. Water/Wastewater Facility Emergency Generator - \$48,300 - Power the command center for essential water/ sewer services during emergencies.
7. Valcor WWTP Emergency Generator - \$48,300 - Provide emergency power and ability to focus on other essential work during emergencies.
8. ~~Fuller Road Culvert Replacement~~ - Not eligible because project is in the bidding phase.
9. ~~Jenkins, Mason & Pleasant Streets Stormwater Mitigation~~ - Too involved for current grant application deadline. Include in EFC preplanning grant study. Possible WQIP funding.
10. ~~Mannix Road Stormwater Mitigation~~ - Not enough documented damages to qualify.
