Local Law No. 1 of 2003

A Local Law prohibiting all parking on roads and highways in the Town of Peru where "no parking" signs are in place.

This Local Law is in the interest of the general public welfare, in order to expedite the removal of snow, to reduce driving hazards, and to ensure the existence of open roads.

Therefore, any vehicle found parked or abandoned, in violation of this Local law, shall be deemed a nuisance and a menace to traffic and may be removed and/or impounded. All costs incurred will be charged against the vehicle's owner who, if further convicted of a traffic infraction as a result of violation of this Law, may be additionally subject to a fine of up to \$50.

The only exception allowed shall be for local merchants and delivery trucks, which may park immediately in front of their place of business temporarily to load or unload, providing it does not interfere with snow removal procedures.

The Local Law shall be enforced by the New York State Police, Clinton County Sheriff's Department, Town Constable, or other agent of the Town, as deemed applicable.

This Local Law shall be effective upon the filing of a copy hereof with the Secretary of State.
