

# PERU CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT COMMUNITY REPORT

## **Budget Notice**

Peru Central School District's Board of Education has established a \$52,977,093 proposed expenditure plan for voter consideration. The vote will take place at the High School Community Room from 12:00 noon until 9:00 P.M. on May 16th or by requesting an absentee ballot because of a qualifying condition. Completed absentee ballots must be received by not later than 5:00 P.M. on May 16, 2023. The 2023-24 proposal calls for an estimated tax levy increase of 2.38%. There are two (2) vacant seats to be filled on the Board of Education.

The individual receiving the highest number of votes will be elected to a term of July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2028, plus will serve from May 17, 2023 – July 1, 2023. The individual receiving the second highest number of votes will be elected to a five-year term of July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2028. The candidates will appear on the ballot as follows:
